

A Bylaw Concerning the Erection and Observance of Highway
Traffic Signs

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440
of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression "road" means any public high-
way within this municipality as defined by the Highways and
Transportation Act other than a provincial highway as designated
pursuant to such Act.
2. The Council may by resolution provide for the erection and
maintenance of stop signs at any intersection of roads designated
and by such resolution.
3. The provisions of section 140 (1) of the Vehicles Act, 1957,
shall apply in respect of every stop sign erected and maintained
pursuant to section 2 hereof.
4. The Council may by resolution provide for the erection and
maintenance of yield the right of way signs at any intersection
of roads designated by such resolution.
5. The provisions of section 138 (2) of the Vehicles Act, 1957,
shall apply in respect of every yield the right of way sign
erected and maintained pursuant to section 4 thereof.
6. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection (2) hereof, the
council may by resolution provide for the erection and maintenance
of any road, and at any designated point or points thereon, of
such signs as it may deem expedient for the legal control,
warning, guidance, direction or information of traffic thereon.

(2) Nothing in subsection (1) shall be deemed to authorize
the erection or maintenance of signs on any road indicating
a maximum speed limit.
7. All signs erected and maintained under the provisions of
sections 2, 4, and subsection (1) of section 6 hereof shall be
of a size, shape, design and color approved for the purpose
by the Minister of Highways and Transportation.
8. The provisions of the Vehicles Act, 1957, shall apply,
wherever applicable to every traffic sign erected and maintained
pursuant to subsection (1) of section 6 hereof.
9. No person shall alter, damage, remove, deface, knock down
or tamper with any traffic sign erected and maintained pursuant
to this bylaw.
10. Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw shall
be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction
to the penalties as provided in the general penalty bylaw of
the municipality, being No. 1/59, passed on the 2nd day of July,
1959.
