Bylaw 4, 1972.

REGIONAL LIBRARY BYLAW

WHEREAS the municipality of Hillsdale No. 440, together with o ther municipalities, pursuant to the Public Libraries Act, 1969, have associated themselves each with the others in establishing and operating a regional library as LAKELAND LIBRARY REGION.

AND WHEREAS the terms of such association to be performed by each of the maid municipalities have been set out in the agreement between those municipalities and have been confirmed by bylaw of each of the said municipalities;

AND WHEREAS the said agreement provides for the admission of other municipalities for the said purpose and upon the same terms;

NOW THEREFORE THE **LAKELAND LIB**RARY REGION and COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HILLSDALE NO. 440 IN OPEN MEETING ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known as the Regional Library Bylaw
- 2. It shall be lawful for the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 to enter into the said agreement wit the said associated municipalities and with such other municipalities as have been or may be admitted as associated municipalities for the said purpose as outli in the agreement.
- 3. The Reeve and Secretary Treasurer are herby authorized, empowered, and directed to execute the said agreement obehalf of the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 and to attach the Corporate Seal of the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 thereto and to do or cause to be done all acts, matters, and things which may be necessary for the due performance and fulfilmen of the terms of the said agreement.
- 4. The bylaw shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of the final passing thereof.
