

BYLAW NO. 1/68

A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 of Saskatchewan.

A BYLAW TO LICENSE AND REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 of the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Every person who owns, possesses or harbours more than two dogs which term shall, for the purpose of this bylaw, be deemed to mean either a male or female over two months old within the municipality shall obtain a license from the secretary treasurer, and shall pay in advance the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each dog exceeding a maximum of two dogs. The sum payable for a license required after July 1st shall be three-fifths of the charge for a full year.
2. All licenses issued under the provisions of this bylaw shall expire on December 31st next following the date of issue.
3. Any person residing in the municipality who owns, possesses or harbours more than two dogs, and neglects or refuses to take out a license for each dog exceeding the maximum of two dogs therefore shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this bylaw.
4. Every person to whom a license has been issued under this bylaw shall cause his dog to wear a collar to which shall be attached the license tag of this municipality.
5. No licensed dog shall be allowed to run at large in the municipality and for the purpose of this bylaw, a licensed dog shall be deemed to be running at large when it is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor or harbourer of the said licensed dog, or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner or occupant of the said land and when it is not ~~being~~ under control being;
 - (a) in direct and continuous charge of a person competent to control it; or
 - (b) securely confined within an enclosure; or
 - (c) securely fastened so that it cannot roam at will.
6. Any licensed dog found running at large contrary to the provisions of this bylaw may be killed by, or by Order of the municipal constable.
7. No vicious dog shall be allowed to run at large at any time, and such a dog may be killed by the municipal constable.
8. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provision of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty bylaw of the municipality.
