

BYLAW NO. 6/59

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN HAMLETS.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. No vehicle shall be driven at a speed greater than twenty five (25) miles per hour in any hamlet in the municipality.
2. Section 1 shall not apply to ambulances, fire apparatus, or vehicles driven by law enforcement officers on duty or to speed on a provincial highway.
3. Any person found guilty of an infraction of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
4. Bylaws No. 42, passed on the 1st day of August, 1936 and No. 71, passed on the 3rd day of August, 1954, regulating the speed of motor vehicles in hamlets, are hereby repealed.
