BYLAW 6/2017

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXPROPRIATION OF LAND

The Council for the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- The Council of the Rural Municipality of Hillsdale No. 440 deems it necessary to acquire 2.55 acres in NW 06-45-24 W3M for the purpose of acquiring right of way and cannot do so by agreement with the landowner.
