Schedule 'C' Public Works Report

August brought good weather with a few storms.

2022 Road Construction - 'Floyd's Road'

- North/South road has had gravel incorporated
- 400/mile of 1 1/4" road gravel was added, however, with dry conditions it is a bit much. When East/West road is done only 300/mile will be placed.
- Continuing to have good weather to work and progress is steady
- East/West road black dirt is moved, culverts started going in Tuesday

Equipment

- Backhoe, 872 #5 & 872 #2 are coming up on 1000 service hours
- Accumulator switch is fixed in 872 #6 grader

Bridge Inspection happened on August 5, 2022 waiting for information, however, site visit was good. Inspectors did not have anything to flag that was a major concern.

Mowing

- 2 passes on Highway 40 and 21 have been completed and invoiced SK Highways for \$5,992.00 (Calculated through PubWorks \$9,476.82)
- Hired Dean Ostrom for a week to continue mowing while holidays happened

Bob and Dustin are off for harvest so grass mowing has slowed.

RCMP
