

# 2023-2024 SNOW PLOW CUSTOM WORK AGREEMENT

BETWEEN: **RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HILLSDALE NO. 440**  
(hereinafter referred to as “the Municipality”)  
OF THE FIRST PART

(hereinafter referred to as “the owner”)  
OF THE SECOND PART

WHEREAS, the “Owner” is the owner, purchaser or lessee of the following lands;

WHEREAS, the Owner desires the Municipality to snow plow his/her private driveway,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipality and the Owner for the consideration hereinafter named, agree as follows:

1. The Municipality agrees to custom snow plow the private driveway of the Owner when so indicated by hanging the pre-purchased red and yellow sign so it is visible to the passing operator. It shall be understood that such snowplowing shall only be undertaken as part of the regular snow plow route. This route is carried out as per the Snow Plow Policy where bus routes and main roads are first, other maintained roads are second and custom work as last priority. This may take several days. If snow removal is required earlier than this the owner should retain services of a private contractor.
2. The Owner hereby agrees to pay to the Municipality a minimum charge of \$60.00 for a maximum of 15 minutes of plowing. For any additional time spent plowing or discussing will be charge at an hourly rate of \$250.00 thereafter. In the event that the charges for work done are not paid within 60 days of the billing date, the Owner agrees that unpaid bills will be added to and form part of the taxes on the Owner’s property. The Municipality may refuse services for delinquent accounts.
3. The Owner hereby agrees that he/she will purchase a snow removal sign from the Municipal Office. The Owner agrees that when snow removal is required, he/she will place the snow removal sign at the end of the driveway and remove it when the snow has been cleared.
4. The owner hereby agrees that a phone call to the Municipal Office to request snow removal is only required if the Owner is adjacent to a provincial highway.
5. The Municipality shall have the right to refuse to snow plow any private driveway that in the opinion of the snow plow operator will be hazardous or difficult to snow plow. Objects that are concealed because of snow coverage must be marked with stakes or otherwise. Examples: bricks, shrubs or small trees.
6. The Municipality shall have the right to refuse to snow plow any private driveway that in the opinion of the snow plow operator is too narrow in width or where trees have become overgrown.
7. The Owner hereby covenants and agrees that he/she will at times indemnify and save harmless the Municipality, it’s servants, agents and employees from and against all loss, damage or injury however caused, which may at any time during the continuance of this Agreement occur to any person or the property of any person including the Owner.
